Next year.

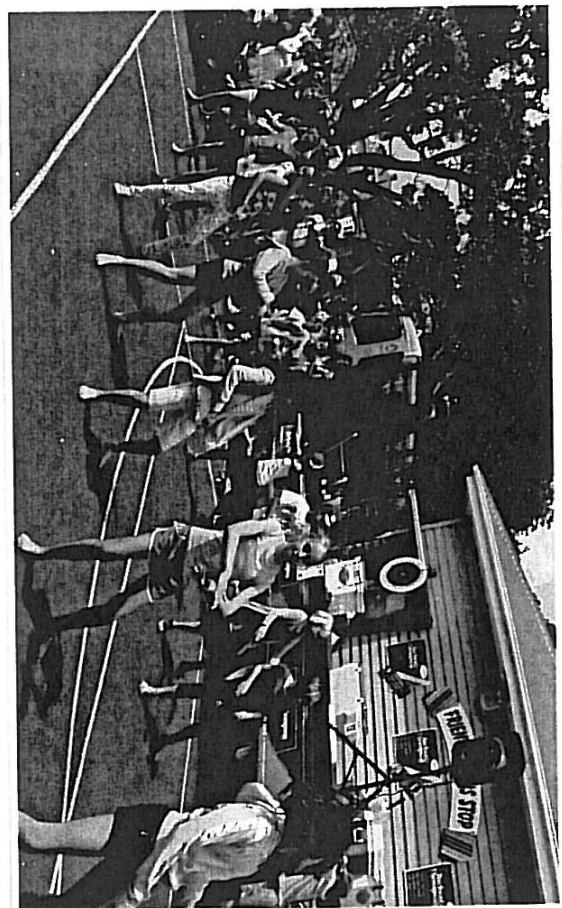
